Old Business

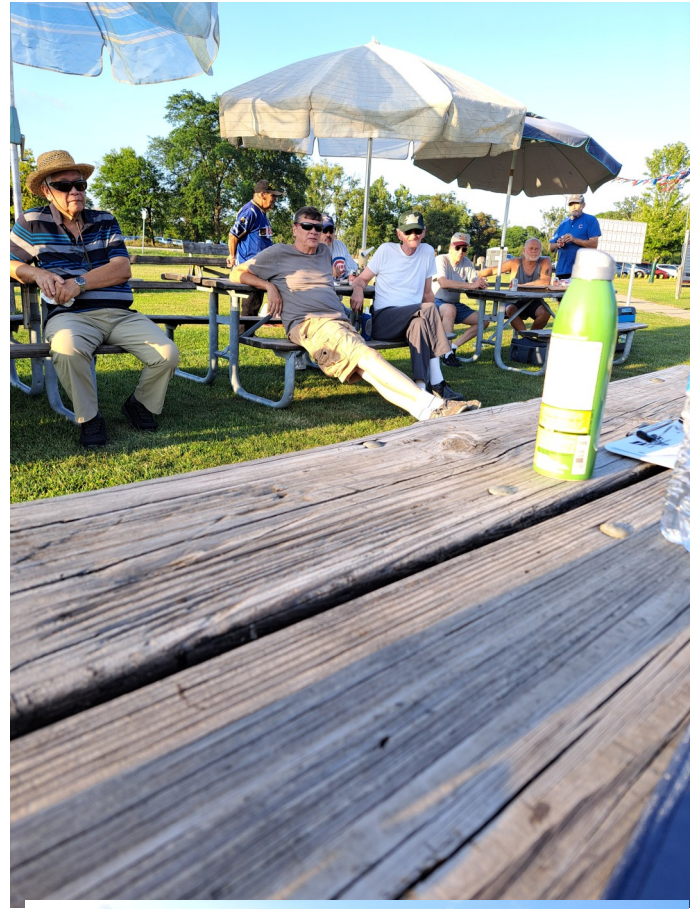
No old business to report.
